## ZARDOZ

Cabernet Sauvignon—Maipo Valley

This wine was named after a horse sired by the famous “Don Alberto” owned by the wineries owners. ZardoZ is made from the best grapes from the Maipo Valley. The wine is aged for 18 to 24 months in oak barrels. After that time it is blended and then bottled unfiltered.

**Tasting Notes:** Delicious red color with mulberry dyes. Aromas of delicate violets, red fruits and with hazelnuts, cacao and airs of mint. On the palate clean with pretty fruit and smooth tannins, round and elegant. Subtle and distinct, balanced and smooth with a long and pleasant experience.
