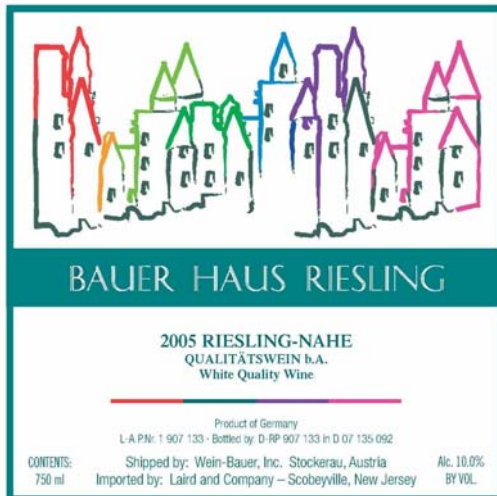

Winery Profile

In 1929 Schloss Koblenz was founded in Koblenz, the famous 2000 years old German town where the rivers Rhein and Mosel join together. The company was located in the beautiful Castle of Koblenz that had been built by the Archbishop of Riesling. He introduced the unique Riesling grape to the Mosel valley.

The majority of the winery is owned by the Selback family, who have been involved in wine growing since 1665. In 2002 the company merged with the Josef Drathen KG Group, one of Germany's largest, most modern and efficient wineries, located in Zell/Mosel and still privately owned.



Bauer Haus Riesling

This Riesling wine has peach and fine apple aromas with a crisp acidity that results in a well balanced, easy to drink wine.

It is perfect as an aperitif or to complement a wide range of foods from pork and ham to fish and poultry.



Bauer Haus Spätlese

This full bodied wine is well balanced and firm, giving it an intense and lingering finish. It is produced from fully ripened grapes.

Excellent by itself or served with cheeses, oriental food and richly flavored meats and poultry.

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
