Azienda Agricola Marega is situated on the border of Italy and the former Yugoslavia, in the DOC growing district known as Collio. The Collio district is well known for producing some of Italy's finest white wines.

Giorgio Marega has taken over the reins of the family winery. The production is very limited and great care is taken every step of the way, from growing the grapes to bottling and shipping the wines. He purposely late harvest their grapes in order to concentrate the varietal character and fruit flavors of each different grape variety.

Marega Pinot Grigio

Up until very recently, the estate only produced varietal wines. The Marega style extracts great body and character from the white as well as the red grapes. As a result, even the white wines are capable of aging. This exceptional Pinot Grigio leads the way with its grace, power and style.

This wine is light and fruity, with ripe green apple and pear flavors. A hint of citrus adds to a crisp finish. (Alc. by Vol. 12%)
