Mauro and Giovanni are both oenologists and graduates of the school of Viticulture in Conegliano. Being family owned and operated assures the wines high quality. Most wines competing at this price are produced by large corporations or co-operative growers where no one person oversees the quality of the product and puts his name on the bottle. ## Stival Pinot Grigio

The Venetos most popular grape, Pinot Grigio, makes this wine pleasant, crisp and very refreshing.

A light straw yellow color with a characteristic bouquet of fruit and acacia blossoms. Light and dry, this wine is easy to drink on its own or with any lightly flavored dish. (ABV 11%)



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## **Stival Cabernet Sauvignon**

Cabernet Sauvignon is still the most revered red wine grape in the world. This wine is ruby red in color with a characteristically elegant bouquet.

This grape makes a full, rich and complex wine. Although this wine is not intended for long aging, you will experience the complexity, intensity and structure that make this grape noble. (ABV 12%)

## **Stival Chardonnay**

Stival Chardonnay is fuller and has more body than the Pinot Grigio. It has a bright, sparkling straw yellow color with a subtle elegant fruity and floral bouquet.

This Chardonnay is ripe and very drinkable at the same time. Most importantly, Stival Chardonnay is a very good value. (ABV 12%)
